Mr. McQuaid is a Budget Examiner in the Investment Branch, National Security Division, Office of Management and Budget. As such he is a member of the OMB Working Group for the revision of OMB's Circular A-76: Performance of Commercial Activities and serves as a liaison with DoD in the development and approval of OMB's Scorecard for DoD's Competitive Sourcing Program, DoD's Budget and Performance Integration Initiative and DoD's implementation of the Government Performance Results Act, including clearing Performance Measurement Plans and Reports, performance pilots, and performance-budget metrics. Mr. McQuaid is responsible for the review of DoD's FAIR Act inventory and for inventories submitted by the National Intelligence Agencies and the National Nuclear Safety Administration. Mr. McQuaid has also been responsible for OMB's coordination of the Defense Department's Revolution in Business Affairs, including the Defense Reform Initiative and Acquisition Reform Center. He is the OMB Budget Examiner for DoD-wide Real Property Maintenance (\$4+billions/year) and Backlog of Maintenance and Repair.

Mr. McQuaid holds a Masters in Economics, University of California at Berkeley and a Masters of Social Sciences, San Francisco State University. A member of the American Economic Association and the American Association for Budget and Program Analysis, Mr. McQuaid is a Real Estate Agent licensed in Washington, D.C. and the State of Maryland.
